### 2019 Flu season- notice

Flu season is right around the corner. For most, flu is an inconvenience that will cause a few days of fever, cough, and generally feeling unwell. For some, the highly contagious disease can lead to severe complications that require hospitalization or worse.

Immunizations are the best way to protect yourself, your family and those around you from the flu. The vaccine is safe, effective and proactive. Early vaccination means you are better protected. The Saskatchewan Health Authority will begin its seasonal flu clinics on October 21, 2019.

Vaccine is available to all Saskatchewan residents over the age of six months, free of charge. Any person can attend public clinics to receive their immunization. Participating pharmacies can vaccinate children five years of age and older. To find a public clinic near you, please visit [www.4flu.ca](http://www.4flu.ca) or call **HealthLine at 811**. In addition to the public health clinics, you may choose to receive your immunization from participating physician/nurse practitioner offices and pharmacists. Keep yourself and your loved ones protected from flu this season, get your flu shot!
