Firebird North is an exciting not-for-profit program that provides music and movement instruction at no cost for children in underserved communities. Firebird was instituted in Prince Albert in 2019 and is overseen by a volunteer board. The program runs from mid-September to mid-May, from 3:00-5:15 every school day at King George School.

The coordinator is a paid position that acts as liaison with parents and instructors, and is on-site daily to oversee and assist with program management. There is a small amount of administrative work also required. Although not required, a background in childhood development/education or some music background would be an asset. However, critical qualities include excellent interpersonal and communication skills, strong organizational abilities, and a philosophical alignment with the intent of Firebird, which is to build a supportive community structure for children.
