Thanks to all for their support of the SCC! Have a great Easter!

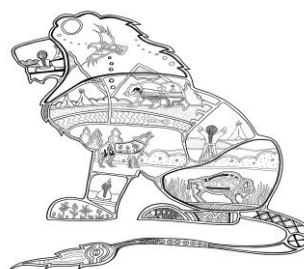
