King George School will be having its annual **Walk-a-thon**, regardless of the weather, on **Thursday, May 9th (Pre-K & Kindergarten will walk on Wednesday, May 8th)**. We will stagger the departure times in the afternoon. All students will walk towards and around Kinsmen Park. The distance is 3.2 Km but it will vary, depending on how far teachers and students wish to walk.

The money raised will be used for things like: the purchase of library books; sports equipment for the school/gym and classrooms; visits from artists, authors, and performers; bus costs for educational trips; technology, and special events/presentations, etc.
