
Our student's safety is our top priority.

SCC Message

The SCC is in the planning stages of a massive project to replace and update school playground equipment at King George School. There is no government funding for schools to purchase playground equipment. So, it falls on parents/guardians and the SCC to fundraise and purchase playground equipment and other items that the school does not have a budget for. Much of King George's playground equipment is very old and will need replacement soon, therefore, SCC is trying to take a proactive approach to replace the equipment before it is necessary to remove it because it beyond its lifespan and unsafe for students to use.

SCC became aware of this situation in 2021 when the school board informed King George that all the swings were going to be removed that school year because they were too old, and they were required to be replaced. That was almost a \$30,000 price tag. Principal Feher successfully negotiated with the school board that the school would remove the swings over a two-year period while SCC fundraised to replace them. Over those 2 years and with a lot of effort the SCC successfully fundraised the monies to replace the swings. Last school year we fundraised and purchased much needed chairs for the school.

The **minimum** price tag on a playground is \$50,000..... so, SCC has a very lofty goal. Our "dream" is to replace the old playground equipment on both sides of the school which the estimated cost is in excess of \$100,000. We are in the planning stages of a multi-phase project which will occur over many years to achieve. We will report on the playground project as we finalize plans.

In pursuit of raising funds for the playground project SCC will be having their annual bucket raffle/silent auction at the school Christmas Concert on December 11th, 2024. Tickets will be \$1 each for the bucket raffle (CASH only). How it works is there will be a bucket for each item being raffled off and every ticket you purchase can be placed in the bucket or buckets for the item(s) you want to win. There have been many awesome prizes won in past years. We will have this year's items posted on the school's social media Facebook and Instagram prior to the concert. Come early to the concert to buy your tickets as sales will close once the concert starts. We will have a silent auction that will close prior to the concert if bigger ticket items are donated.

SCC members are currently pounding the pavement with letters to businesses asking for donations for the bucket raffle and bigger ticket items for a silent auction. If you are interested in helping out dropping off letters to businesses or have any items to donate to bucket raffle/silent auction please call the school for arrangements to pick up a letter or drop donation items.
