SCC Message

Greetings from the School Community Council,

The SCC is in the planning stages of a project to purchase new school playground equipment. We estimate at minimum we will need to fundraise at least \$50,000 over the next few years to replace equipment.

As part of fundraising for the playground project are having a Co-op gift card fundraiser starting mid-March. We will be asking the students to sell Coop gift cards to friends and family. There will be prizes for top selling students. If the school has gift card purchases between \$5,000 and \$14,999.00 Co-op will donate 5% the value of the sales back to the SCC, 7 % back for sales between \$15,000 and 10% back for sales over \$34,999.00 to \$60,000.00. The cards can be used at any Western Canadian Co-op gas, liquor, grocery, for consumer purchases. We greatly appreciate the help students and family provide towards our fundraising projects!

1. Always avoid the staff parking lot on 23rd Street. Students can get dropped off and picked up near the sidewalk.
