#### **SCC Message**

Greetings from the School Community Council,

The SCC is in the planning stages of a project to purchase new school playground equipment. We estimate at minimum we will need to fundraise at least \$50,000 over the next few years to replace equipment.

As part of fundraising for the playground project are having a Co-op gift card fundraiser starting mid-March. We will be asking the students to sell Coop gift cards to friends and family. There will be prizes for top selling students. If the school has gift card purchases between \$5,000 and \$14,999.00 Co-op will donate 5% the value of the sales back to the SCC, 7% back for sales between \$15,000 and 10% back for sales over \$34,999.00 to \$60,000.00. The cards can be used at any Western Canadian Co-op gas, liquor, grocery, for consumer purchases. We greatly appreciate the help students and family provide towards our fundraising projects!
