King George School will be having its annual Walk-a-thon, regardless of the weather, on Thursday, May 8th (Pre-K & Kindergarten will walk on Wednesday, May 7th). We will stagger the departure times in the afternoon. All students will walk towards and around Kinsmen Park. The distance is 3.2 Km but it will vary, depending on how far teachers and students wish to walk.

The money raised will be used for things like: the purchase of library books; sports equipment for the school/gym and classrooms; visits from artists, authors, and performers; bus costs for educational trips; technology, and special events/presentations, etc.

## Please Note:



1. Always avoid the staff parking lot on 23<sup>rd</sup> Street. Students can get dropped off and picked up near the sidewalk.
2. When dropping off students before the beginning of the day, please **drop them off at their recess door**. When it is cold outside, we have teachers at the door letting them in. The front door becomes very busy at the start and end of the day. If students are late, they are asked to come through the front door.
3. There are days where approximately 40 students are late. This makes the office very busy, and students may be missed when they come in and they miss valuable instruction time. **Reminder that classes begin at 8:25 am and 12:30 pm in the afternoon.**
