Please Note:



1. Always avoid the staff parking lot on 23rd Street. Students can get dropped off and picked up near the sidewalk.
2. When dropping off students before the beginning of the day, please **drop them off at their recess door**. When it is cold outside, we have teachers at the door letting them in. The front door becomes very busy at the start and end of the day. If students are late, they are asked to come through the front door.
3. There are days where approximately 40 students are late. This makes the office very busy, and students may be missed when they come in and they miss valuable instruction time. ***Reminder that classes begin at 8:25 am and 12:30 pm in the afternoon.***
