Please Note:

1. Always avoid the staff parking lot on 23rd Street. Students can get dropped off and picked up near the sidewalk.

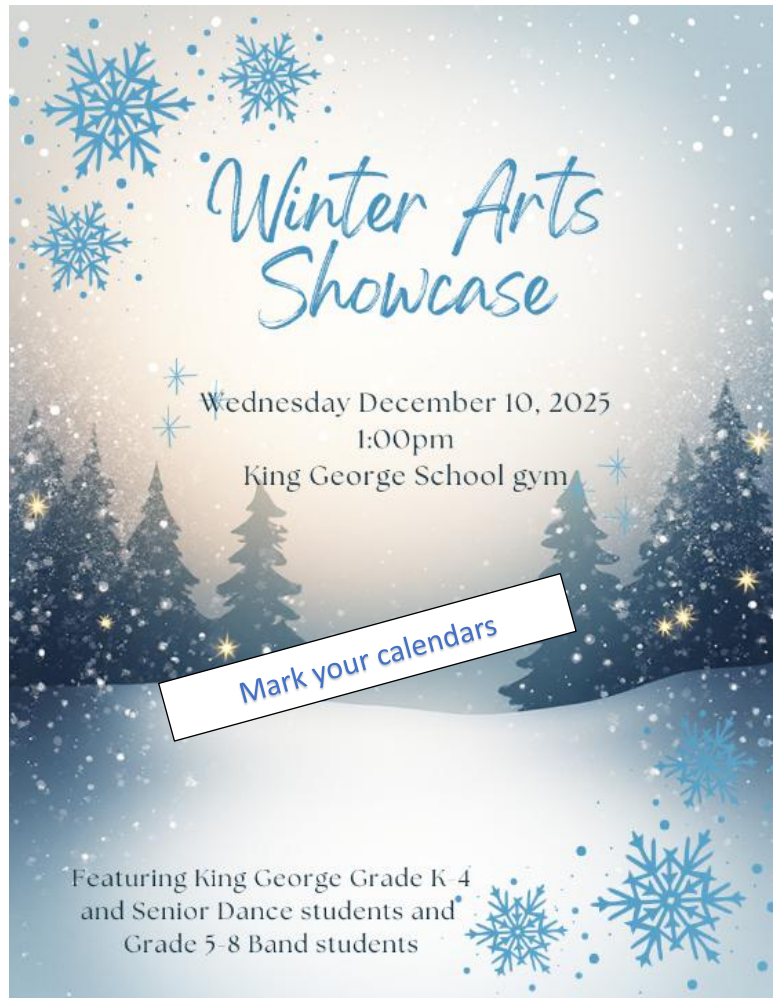
