Everyone is welcome to see what students have been working on in classes this year, as well as some KG talented students

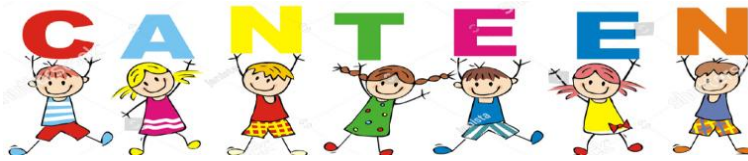


### Please Note:
